#### 11. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT:

The proposed road off takes from Noorpur Thal city and terminates on Khushab Muzaffargarh road at District boundary. The length of this road is 55 KM having metalled width 10′ to 12′ and was in poor condition and deteriorated. It connects many populated areas to Tehsil Head quarter Noorpur Thal. The widening / improvement of this road not only facilitated the people of surrounding area but also reduced the traveling distance from Jhang, Multan to Noorpur Thal, Mianwali by 30 Km, which will save public money in terms of saving time, fuel consumption an better facilities for public transports travailing of this road. The administrative approval was issued by the Secretary C&W Department, Lahore vide No. SOH-II(C&W)3-15/2017/ (KHB) dated 15.01.2018 amounting to Rs. 763.316 (M) & Amended administrative approval was issued by the Secretary C&W Department, Lahore vide No. SOH-III(C&W)3-15/2017/ (KHB) dated 21.02.2018 amounting to Rs. 829.365 (M) for 55 KM length. The Part Technical Sanctioned by the Chief Engineer (N), Punjab Highway Department, Lahore vide Memo No. ADP/6786/2016-17/KHB/ 618/Plg dated 26.02.2018 amounting to Rs. 536.209 Million. The revised administrative approval was issued by the Secretary C&W Department,

Lahore vide No.SOH-II(C&W)2-8/2022/ (Khushab) dated 28.10.2022 amounting to Rs. 881.300 (M)
